OFFICIAL 2010 NEW MELONES OPEN TEAM KOKANEE TOURNAMENT

1. All participants in boat a must be derby entrants. Non-fishing "ride-a-longs" are not permitted and violators may be disqualified from prize contention.
2. All California Fish and Game regulations are in effect. Breaking any DFG regulations or Coast Guard Boating rules may result in disqualification. Life jackets must be aboard each boat for each participant and may be checked.
3. Fishing starts at 5:30 AM. Fishing officially stops at 12:00 NOON and all anglers MUST be in line by 1:00 PM to have their catch measured / weighed at the boat ramp.
4. **Tournament TEAMS shall consist of one (1) but not more than 4 participants in one boat. EACH BOAT SHALL HAVE NO MORE THAN 4 RODS IN THE WATER AT ANY TIME.**
5. **No Entries will be taken after July 5, 2010, no exceptions. NO Walk-Ins.**
6. **Two ways to win: (1) winning five (5) fish limit will be determined by either weight or length per team as determined by the chairman at check in time, and (2) One (1) biggest fish in weight or length as determined by the chairman at check in time. (this fish will not be included in the 5 fish limit)**
7. In case of a tie, a coin flip by the weight/length master will determine the place of finish.
8. Entry verification and personal identification may be required at time of weigh-in.
9. Any fish showing signs of tampering or considered questionable by DFG or CIFFI judges will not be considered at this derby.
10. Derby participants are not allowed to hire professional guides or charter boat captains. Guides and charter Captains are welcome to enter the Derby as participants but may not guide clients or charge for services.
11. All participants must adhere to all provisions of the Law and abide with the above mentioned rules of sportsmanship and fair play.
12. **YOU MUST HAVE FUN! After all... that's what these derbies are all about.**

******* Keep these rules handy *******

Check-in will be located at Glory Hole Sports Friday, July 9th, 3 to 8 pm or Saturday AM at Glory Hole launch area.. All boats to launch at the launch site at the Glory Hole ramp site. Weigh-in at Glory Hole Ramp Area will be CLEARLY MARKED. Further information will be in the entry confirmation letter.
